### **Dr. Judson Jay Scott, Artistic Director**

Dr. Scott holds positions as trumpet instructor at the University of Puget Sound and principal trumpet with Northwest Sinfonietta. He is an active performer on modern and baroque trumpet in the Puget Sound region and has performed with Seattle Symphony Orchestra, Seattle Opera Company, and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Theater, among many others. Judson holds degrees in trumpet performance from Baldwin-Wallace College (Bachelors) and New England Conservatory (Masters), and a Doctor of Musical Arts in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Washington. He joined Brass Band Northwest as Artistic Director in March 2011.

### **BBNW Background and Musical Presence**

**Brass Band Northwest**, grounded in the tradition of the British brass band, was founded in 2002 with the goal of sharing the vibrant and exciting sound of all-brass music with audiences of all ages in the Pacific Northwest. The instrumentation includes: cornets, flugelhorn, alto horns, baritones, euphoniums, trombones, and tubas, plus percussion. Our repertoire combines traditional brass band works, symphonic masterworks, jazz and pop classics.

The band is composed of professional, semi-professional, and amateur musicians who rehearse weekly and perform 4-5 major concerts a year. In addition, BBNW performs at a variety of other events, such as the Leavenworth Christmas Lighting Festival, Yarrow Point's Independence Day Celebration, and Seattle Mariners games.

Brass Band Northwest presents the Northwest Brass Band Festival on the last Saturday of January each year, hosting bands from California to British Columbia. The day is spent in clinics and performance with internationally recognized band clinicians and guest soloists. Past guest soloists and conductors include Patrick Sheridan, Mark Gould, Deanna Swoboda, Philip Sparke, James Curnow, Douglas Yeo, James Gourlay, Helen Tyler, and local favorite, Allen Vizzutti.
